



Summit Police Department Trading Card Program

Please adhere to the guidelines listed below so that the Summit Police Department Trading Card Program will be a fun and safe experience for everyone:

- To receive a trading card from an officer, please have your child approach the officer and introduce themselves (Name, Age and School are good starting points).
- Police Officers will sign their individual trading card, if requested.
- Police Officers may only have a limited amount of trading cards on them at any given time.
- Parents and/or Guardians are not allowed to collect the cards for their children as the purpose behind the program is for the children to experience positive interaction with the Police Officers.
- Students are not allowed to collect trading cards during school hours.
- A different Police Officer that works the late shift will be featured every month during the program and their trading card will be available at the Police Dispatch Window.
- Please visit the Police Department's website (located at www.cityofsummit.org) for updates on times and dates to meet Police Chief Robert Weck and Mayor Ellen Dickson to collect their cards. The site will also have updates on the program.
- Police Officers may have to answer an emergency call at any given moment, if this occurs, please explain to your child so that they do not think the officer was being rude.

To keep everyone safe, these rules MUST be followed:

- Do not approach a Police Officer when they are on a call (working with residents, drivers, etc.)
- Do not approach a Police Officer when their police car emergency lights are on.
- Do not approach a Police Officer when they are on a traffic post (examples: directing traffic, crossing students, etc.)
- **#1 RULE: Please do not disregard your safety or the Officer's to collect a trading card.**

Guidelines for Raffle Prizes

- The Police Records Bureau (in City Hall) will handle the various trading card verifications below Monday through Friday, from 3:00-4:00 PM.
- Collect 20 out of 56 cards, the child will be entered into the raffle prize drawing and receive the Special Trading Card # 1.
- Collect 40 out of 56 cards, the child will be entered into the raffle prize drawing a second time.
- Collect all 56 cards, the child will be entered into the raffle prize drawing a third time and will also receive a poster of all the trading cards (numbers are limited!)
- Multiples of one officer will only be counted as one card.
- The raffle is limited to elementary aged students (Pre-K through 5th grade).
