Meeting Minutes

PTO President Melissa Madden welcomed everyone. She mentioned this is the last meeting of the year. Everyone agreed that last night's 4th grade concert was great.

Mrs. Tierney gave a special thanks to Melissa Madden for guidance this year in her first year as principal. She thanked the parents for their involvement and commitment to students in the building, saying it has been amazing. Franklin received an award grant of \$60,000 from SEF.

The school has all the materials needed for shifting indoor recess. Should be ready to start in June. Students will move into a center based approach recess. Playing across grade levels in these new indoor recess areas. Looking to build school community so students meet other students in other grades.

The school practiced a tornado drill during school on Wednesday. Students did great.

Testing for NJSLA went well, very few students opted out. Next year every 3^{rd} and 4^{th} grade will have their own chrome book that stays at school so testing should go faster as students can use the chrome books.

Teacher lists for grades will come out at the end of the year as there are some shifts in teachers.

Kevin Finn leader of the Boy Scouts at Franklin gave an overview of the boy scouts at Franklin. 46 boys are currently enrolled. They doubled the amount of pack events this year. Some events included a camp in at Liberty Science Center, camping at Camp Lakeview, family camping at Watching Reservation which 28 families attended, American essay contest sponsored by the Elks Lodge, treks plastic collection, Pinewood Derby, Rain gutter Regatta add a bottle rocket competition. The pack is flexible so make events that you can and can join in any year. The sign up for next year would be during the first week of school. They will coordinate the date and announcement through the PTO.
