IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION for ANYONE who is responsible for drop off and/or pick up of our Franklin students:

Due to the challenges observed by both staff and parents during drop off and pick up, we will begin to have a police presence with us during this daily routine.

We are asking that you observe ALL signs, traffic regulations and display driver courtesy to ensure the safety of our families. This includes but is not limited to:

- Crossing ONLY at crosswalks with the assistance of our crossing guard
- Parking legally, in designated places
- K turns are not legal during drop off/pick up on Blackburn Road
- Students may not disembark a vehicle that is stopped in the middle of the street. You must pull to a curb to allow your child to exit or enter the car.

I am confident that safety is also your primary focus and appreciate that, through your focused attention to this guidelines, all of our students and families will begin and end their day safely.

Our fifth grade safety patrol has started their volunteer experience. Please remind your students to avail themselves of this wonderful peer resource. Safety vests are on the way to allow students and parents to identify our student volunteers.
