## ATTENDANCE REPORTING

As we continue to provide instruction across both the live and virtual environments, I wanted to take this opportunity to provide a few points of clarification for our families.

- Please report your child's absence to the classroom teacher AND main office.
- Our attendance reporting is a state requirement.
- You may move your student to a virtual instructional setting at any time; however, re-entry to the live classroom must occur with notice provided on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month and re-entry on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month.
- Students may NOT move to and from virtual and live settings for reasons other than illness or as outlined above.
- If your child is registered as an in-person student but is absent and participates in virtual learning, they will still be reported as absent.
- School hours are from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM with 12:30 to 1:30 lunch/recess
