ABSENCE REPORTING

When notifying your child's teacher and Mrs. Napoles of an absence, please include a reason i.e. ill, appointment, travel, etc. Since current health guidelines require that we monitor student absence and re-entry, this information is required to ensure everyone's safety. Guidelines for re-entry following illness are outlined and updated regularly on both the district Health Office Page as well as Mrs. Zanelli's page on the district website: summit.k12.nj.us. ACCESS to VIRTUAL LEARNING

Last year our students were able to access virtual learning freely. This year virtual learning opportunities are only available if the DISTRICT has excluded your child from attending school due to COVID. If your child is ill without a COVID positive result or required quarantine verified by Mrs. Zanelli, your child is ill and should rest. If you have an appointment or are traveling within the school calendar, your child is not eligible for virtual learning. Any assignments may be made up upon their return to school. The school/teacher does not provide assignments, in advance, for purposes of travel.

FORGOTTEN ITEMS

Just a reminder that the ONLY items permitted for drop off during school hours are your child's Chromebook, charger, water bottle, and snack. Lunch can be provided by the cafeteria. We appreciate your cooperation (and know that we can supply, for the day, any other item that is critical to learning =0).

STAFF CELL PHONE USE

Staff are employing cell phones to synchronize time across the school setting. Please use your cell phone to schedule your arrival and pick up as well. This should alleviate any confusion about the accuracy of clocks or personal devices.

CAR LINE, ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

For our experienced Franklin Families – I am thrilled that we were able to get to the 4th week of school without these reminders; however, car line, drop off and pick up procedures have deteriorated quickly.

PLEASE REVIEW the information below as reminders that keep us all SAFE!

- Your child MUST exit on the passenger side of the car ONLY you may not exit the car. If your child cannot exit independently, please park LEGALLY and walk up.
- This is a "kiss & go" line. Your child should be ready to leave the car, masked, when you pull to a stop.

- PLEASE pull <u>ALL THE WAY UP</u> before allowing your child to leave the car.
- This is a SINGLE STOP LINE. You may not stop at multiple points to have children leave the car. They are safe to walk to their designated door from anywhere in the drop off lane.
- PLEASE obey all traffic laws including:
 - a. DO NOT DOUBLE PARK on Warwick and ask your child to exit your car.
 - b. DO NOT DOUBLE PARK on Warwick and send another child out to pick up your child.
 - c. The crossing guard ensures EVERYONE'S safety. Respect and courtesy are not only an expectation but set the example for your child if this individual needs to direct them safely across the street or in the case of an emergency.
 - d. Remain in the crosswalks on Blackburn and on Warwick! Cars come along quickly especially during rush hour.
 - e. There are many, many blind spots around the school during arrival and dismissal. Please guide your child with an awareness that a car may not see you – especially if distracted.
- DROP OFF is 8:15 with a window until 8:25 when the building doors close. PLEASE REMEMBER, students will NOT be entering the building prior to 8:15 (unless it is raining sideways). We do not have the ability to supervise students in smaller groups between 8:05 and 8:15 while maintaining appropriate distance.
