### **CAREGIVER PICK UP**

If your child is being picked up by a care provider/nanny/babysitter – PLEASE review the dismissal procedures with them **as soon as possible.** Today, we had 4 cars parked on the opposite side of Blackburn to collect children from dismissal. Staff reported that they were caregivers. Everyone's safety is at risk. Please speak to them as soon as possible.

### ....AND ON THAT SAME NOTE

I am not sure if you are aware that a parent reported that two people were struck by a car this week on Blackburn Place during arrival. Neither was hurt and everyone was very, very fortunate to be able to walk away. We have reviewed procedures, asked for cooperation and even policed the area with staff and administration; however, we are still trying to manage illegal traffic behavior, double parking, parking illegally, students and adults crossing outside of the crosswalk, discharging students into the street...well, I think you understand. As you know, my first responsibility is to keep our children safe. These reminders are not working. As I have done in the past, I will begin to include photos of cars that are engaging in illegal behaviors placing all at risk. It is my hope that no photos will be included each week reflecting a commitment by all to ensure the safe arrival and dismissal of our students.

### **BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT VIDEOS**

We received some wonderful feedback on this virtual experience from our parents. The videos will remain active for another week or so and are in your mailbox. Just in case you didn't get a chance during the week – please take a moment to review these informative presentations and learn more about your child's daily experience here at Franklin.
