!!! SAFETY ALERT !!!

PLEASE respect the following guidelines as they have been instituted to ensure the safety of not only your child, but everyone in the Franklin School community

MORNING DROP OFF – Adult supervision begins at 8:05 AM. Any student who is on school property prior to that time is **NOT** supervised by a district adult.

DISMISSAL PARKING – Parking on the far side of Blackburn (opposite the main entrance) is ILLEGAL during dismissal and very DANGEROUS as parents/students are attempting to cross the street. PLEASE do not engage in this dangerous behavior. It places everyone at risk!

CAR LINE – Drop off begins at the front of the car line which pulls all the way up to the first banner. We have been experiencing some 5th grade families stopping to drop their students off by the field. This habit is backing up the car line – significantly – impacting all of the families behind these vehicles. We are asking that you respect all of our families who participate in car line drop off and refrain from stopping and discharging your child without pulling all the way up to the car in front of you.

4th **GRADE LINE UP** – Please remind your children to remain on the GRASS as they walk to Warwick field for morning line up. Several students have been observed walking in between parked cars during arrival. Very dangerous with cars entering and exiting the lot!
