Vaccines, Travel & Quarantine

Please refer to Mrs. Zanelli's health office page and/or the district webpage regarding specifics but here are a few highlights:

- Vaccine status for our students must be reported to Mrs. Zanelli by presenting a vaccine card. We cannot accept a verbal report regarding vaccination status. Copies, photos, scanned cards and emails are accepted.
- This documentation, when provided, may impact quarantine requirements following travel and or exposure.
- If you are traveling over the Thanksgiving holiday and will require early dismissal or an absence, please report this ASAP to Mrs. Napoles and copy your child's classroom teacher on the email. If there is an absence needed **PLEASE** include the reason and destination, if traveling. If due to illness it is required that you report the symptoms/illness when reporting the absence.
- ...and remember, if you are traveling outside of the US, quarantine guidelines will be followed upon your return. Remote instruction will be available for those individuals mandated to quarantine; however, teachers have 24 hours to prepare for this instructional model. IF you are traveling outside of the US, please alert the main office ASAP.
