NJ SLA STANDARDIZED TESTING

Grades 3, 4 and 5

TESTING DATES: Mathematics – May 10, 11 & 12
English Language Arts – May 17 & 18

MAKE UP SESSIONS: Math – May 13 & 16
English Language Arts – May 19 & 20

5TH GRADE ONLY: Science – May 23 & 24

Testing is scheduled during the morning. We are asking students to:

GET A GOOD NIGHT'S REST EAT A HEALTHY BREAKFAST ARRIVE PROMPTLY
(If your child arrives after the start of the test, they will not be permitted to test that day. A makeup session will be necessary.)

ALL CHROMEBOOKS MUST ARRIVE FULLY CHARGED EACH DAY. If your child's Chromebook quits during the test, they will be eliminated from the session.

STUDENTS will not be permitted to have any smart device in their possession including watches. PLEASE leave these devices home. If they come to school, they MUST be stored in a backpack. The district will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
