<u>Grades 3, 4 and 5</u>

TESTING DATES: Mathematics - May 10, 11 & 12

English Language Arts - May 17 & 18

MAKE UP SESSIONS: Math - May 13 & 16

English Language Arts - May 19 & 20

5TH GRADE ONLY: Science - May 23 & 24

Testing is scheduled during the morning. We are asking students to:

GET A GOOD NIGHT'S REST EAT A HEALTHY BREAKFAST ARRIVE PROMPTLY (If your child arrives after the start of the test, they will not be permitted to test that day. A makeup session will be necessary.

ALL CHROMEBOOKS MUST ARRIVE FULLY CHARGED EACH DAY. If your child's Chromebook quits during the test, they will be eliminated from the session.
